MUNICIPALITY OF MYKONOS CIVIL WEDDING OFFICE

REQUIREMENTS to CIVIL WEDDINGS

- **A)** <u>For applicants residing in Mykonos</u> (with proof of residence), in order to get the document of wedding license from our office (for each spouse):
 - 1. Complete birth certificate (including parents' data)
 - 2. Certification from Consulate or Embassy of wedding capacity
 - 3. Divorce document (-s) (if there is previous wedding or weddings) or registry of death in case of deceased previous spouse
 - 4. Passports in valid (EU citizens can use their ID card)
 - 5. Permit of residence in Greece valid till the date of the wedding
 - 6. Fee (e-paravolo 18 € and receipt of payment)

Intending spouse should submit petition for wedding license at least 10 days before the wedding, and both spouses, in person, need to submit petition for the wedding ceremony at least two (2) working days before the wedding.

B) For applicants not residing in Mykonos (for each one spouse):

- Wedding license from the competent authorities of the city of residence to get married in Greece
- 2. Complete birth certificate (including parents' data)
- 3. Divorce document (-s) (if there is previous wedding or weddings) or registry of death in case of deceased previous spouse
- 4. Passports in valid (EU citizens can use their ID card)
- 5. Permit of residence in Greece valid till the date of the wedding (just passport / ID card for EU citizens)

Both intending spouses, in person, have submit a petition for the wedding ceremony at least two (2) working days before the wedding date in our office.

Also required **two adults witnesses** present at the wedding with passports.

All foreign papers need to be officially certified with APOSTILLE stamp and

officially translated in Greek by: a) translational Department of Greek

Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Athens, or b) Greek Embassy / Consulate in

applicant's country, if there is public servant who translates c) by Greek

lawyer in Greece, or by d) Official translator graduate from Ionian University

All the translated Names-Towns- Countries must begin with a capital letter and continue with small letters and should have the appropriate accents

The original documents (NO PHOTOCOPIES) have to be attached to the

translations.

The apostille stamp has to be also translated. (The documents must bear the

apostille stamp and THEN to be translated).

Papers from countries that do not require APOSTILLE stamp, need to be

stamped from both Foreign Authorities and Greek Embassy.

ALL THE ABOVE DOCUMENTS SHOULD BE SENT (BY E-MAIL) ONE MONTH BEFORE THE SCHEDULED WEDDING CEREMONY IN ORDER TO BE CHECKED BY THE RELEVANT

DEPARTMENT.

ALL THE ABOVE DOCUMENTS THAT ARE SUBMITTED TO THE MUNICIPALITY OF MYKONOS ARE THEN THE PROPERTY OF THE MUNICIPALITY AND WILL NOT BE RETURNED TO THE

COUPLE.

The civil wedding ceremony takes place in the City Hall, on Tuesday and

Thursday, between 13:00 – 15:00.
